Final Report

- 1. Document the history or origin of your work site. (i.e. when, where, how, why it began, who created it)
- 2. Identify any potential or unsafe working conditions at your workplace. What procedures have been established to make your workplace safer? What can you suggest to make your worksite safer?
- 3. Based on your worksite, discuss
 - a) the educational background required for this career field
 - b) the colleges/universities/apprenticeship that offer training in the field
 - c) length of training period
 - d) name of courses that are considered essential in the training period
 - e) the starting salary in this career field today
 - f) other jobs which contribute to the business where you work.
- 4. Define any 8 terms that you have encountered at your worksite (ie. dentures, spreadsheet, ECG etc.)
- 5. a) Tell us how your personal growth, maturity, outlook on life and frame of mind have been influenced by your involvement with co-op this semester.
 - b) Write yourself a brief self-evaluation on how well you are doing, and give yourself a rating from 1 to 10. Justify your rating
- 6. a) What did you learn in the area of cooperation? Did you see it in action, if so, explain where or how?
 - b) Describe a positive experience working with someone.
 - c) Define "initiative". What does it mean "to take initiative". How have you or might you demonstrate initiative on the job.
- 7. a) Has the program allowed you to become more at ease in a variety of situations? State how various aspects of your work have changed you.
 - b) List some of the skills you have learned and explain how they are important to your being effective in your placement
