Instructions for Completing the Grade 9 Course Selections

Note: This is a Reference Sheet for completing course selections. If you are a student at one of our feeder schools, you will input your courses directly into XELLO with the assistance of your Grade 8 teacher.

Compulsory Courses

Choose the five compulsory courses, one in each subject area (English, French, Geography, Mathematics, and Science) Course descriptions are in the DSBN Program & Course Calendar and in the Open House package.

Choosing Arts Credits and Elective Credits

<u>Usually</u> students choose <u>one</u> Arts Credit <u>AND</u> <u>one</u> Elective Credit; however, students can choose two Arts Credits with permission. Indicate your second choice for each in case of a timetable conflict.

Choosing Alternate Credits

Students are asked to choose one Arts Credit Alternate and one Elective Credit Alternate. These <u>MAY</u> replace one or both of the student's first choices depending on timetable conflicts. Guidance will look to the Alternates on a needs basis when the new timetable is complete in June

Healthy Active Living Credit

Indicate PPL101 or PAR201 for your physical education credit. If you are planning on taking Healthy Active Living in Summer School, please note that the Summer School course course and our course codes are different which means students **can** earn all three credits. Any of them will count toward their physical education compulsory credit.

Completing the Process

For students coming from within DSBN, you will complete your course selections online with your Grade 8 Teacher who will ask you to return a SIGNED copy of your course selections to forward to the Guidance Department at Westlane on your behalf.

For students coming from outside of the DSBN, please submit directly to our Guidance Office.

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
