Grade ten students will be taking an online version of the OSSLT on October 20th. Information about the test is provided below.

There will be five prep sessions, and then a practice-run of the test on October 13th. Students will attend prep sessions during their MSIP period. A schedule of the prep sessions can be found below.

What is on the OSSLT Assessment?

This assessment evaluates the literacy skills students are expected to have learned across all subjects up to the end of grade 9.

Each question on every EQAO assessment is based directly on The Ontario Curriculum, which is what students are learning in classrooms every day.

Do students have to study for the Online OSSLT?

The test is based on the Ontario Curriculum up to the end of grade 9 and while no special preparation is technically required, it is highly recommended that students be explicitly familiar with the new online test format, the types of digital tools offered and the types of questions the students must answer.

- After Hours Literacy Sessions
- Grade 9 Practice test

If a student scored below level 2 on grade 3 and grade 6 EQAO, it is highly recommended that the student work with teachers for extra support to prepare for the grade 10 OSSLT assessment.
