

Welcome to the DSBN Hockey Canada Skills Academy Course

Message to Students and Parents:

Thank you for your interest in the DSBN Hockey Canada Skills course.

We are very excited to provide students with this unique opportunity to combine formalized hockey training in an academic setting, keeping in mind, the overall goal of educating and inspiring students to achieve well in both areas. Many studies have confirmed that student learning tends to excel when the topic is directly related to student interest. Hopefully, this philosophy will enhance the overall "school experience" for every student.

Program Routine

The program will run Monday through Friday and will consist of On-Ice skill development (Gale Center) and Off-Ice personal fitness, classroom theory, concussion awareness and healthy living.

On-Ice

The On-Ice skill development component will take place on Tuesday's and Wednesday's from 9am to 10:45am at the Gale Center.

Off-Ice

On Monday, Thursday and Friday students will attend Westlane Secondary School from 8:30 am to 10:45 am to participate in the "off-ice" portion of the course. This will include classroom activities, personal training and participation in various sports.

All magnet students (students from A.N.Myer and Stamford) will be transported to and from their home school to participate in the program

Students who are not "Magnet" students will have to provide their own transportation to Westlane. However, students will be transported from Westlane to the Gale Center during the On-Ice days.

Cost
